I saw sericulture in my village. There are two farmers doing sericulture from last 10 years. They are getting more money than sugarcane and other crops. Earlier I am doing Sugarcane and Maize. But I am not happy. In an average I got one lakh rupees per year from one acre. So my family decide to turn on sericulture. First I visit to sericulturist farmers in my village with my family. We saw all practical works. Then as per the discussion I visit Sericulture office at Pandharpur and I register my name in the office.

As per the guidance of office staff I plant one acre mulberry garden in 2015-16 with saplings. I made mulberry nursery in my farm. I got Rs. 20000/- subsidy from RKVY scheme for plantation. I decide to erect pakka rearing house. The size of rearing is 50 feet x 25 feet. I got Rs. 87500/- subsidy from RKVY scheme for rearing shade.

I took 4 – 5 crop per year. In 2018-19 I took 1400 Bivolitine Dfls. From these Dfls I got 760 Kgs cocoons and fetched price Rs. 252100/- I am happy with this earning. My family had taken interest in sericulture she support me everywhere. Due to support of sericulture department and my family member I got this success. I Suggest to all farmers to do sericulture with the proper guidance of officials. The leaf quality and quantity also disinfection of rearing is very important factor in sericulture.
