

## **Success Story-1**

**Name of the beneficiary:** Sri Lalit Mohan Tripura, S/O Lt. Bisu Rai Tripura

**Name of the scheme by which benefit extended:** Pisciculture in newly created and reclaimed water bodies under MGNREGA during the last year under RKVY 2015-16.

**Name of the G.P/ADC:** Thalibari ADC Village.

**Name of Block :** Kathalia R.D. Block, Sonamura, Sepahijala Tripura.

Sri Lalit Mohan Tripura is a small fish farmer who used to do fish culture in his 0.48 hectare water area. In the year 2015-16, as a part of Govt. programme, a scheme was given to him to implement the scheme “Pisciculture in newly created and reclaimed water bodies in 0.16 Ha.area. Fishery input in the form of 1640 nos. fingerlings, 48 kg. lime, 70 kg MOC, 178 kg sinking pelleted feed, 177kg floating pellet feed, 50 kg fee (Dust), 8 kg natural zeolite, 2 bottles medicines and 2 days training on scientific fish culture was given to him in the said scheme. The cost of scheme was Rs.17400/- per 0.16 ha and the culture period was for one year as per the guidelines of RKVY.

As a result of adoption of scientific culture of multiple stocking and multiple harvesting practices, he got a total production of 447 kg fish from the scheme i.e (@ 2794 kg/ha), out which 385 kg was sold in market and earned an amount of Rs.65,450/- & rest quantum of 62 kg fish was consumed by his family. The production thus obtained accounted three times more profit from a small unit area of 0.16 ha.
