- Selected feasible fruit and vegetable for intervention programme with the experts opinion and participants need and interest.
- Organized a brain storming session followed by training, interactive session, demonstrations, distribution of literature, motivation lectures and provided guidance about SHG formation.
- Exposure visit was organized for all participants to COE on fruits at Mangiana. The visit provided them first hand information on concepts, problems and management of fruit nurseries, poly house of green house nurseries. Farm women got skill exposure about fruit budding and saplings at COE, which resulted in natural acquisition of skills among all participants.
