Brief note of the project

Samakbual zau cluster is located 4kms from Thingsul tlangnuam village, more than 57 farmers have land in this cluster but most of them are very poor and they could not developed their land for wet rice cultivation, the main system of farming is shifting cultivation in this areas.

During 2014-2015 Land Development work had been implemented from RKVY scheme in Samakbual cluster which coverd 20 Ha of land and 45 families benefited. With the opportunity of this scheme 42 families of Thingsul tlangnuam village started cultivation of rice as permanent farming in this Cluster. The Production of rice as well as vegetable increased every year. Almost all farmers in this cluster are able to cultivate vegetables in their WRC areas after harvesting paddy, which gives extra income during rabi season.
