

Problem of the Area:

☐ Farmers of this project areas are Schedule cast, tribal, poor & backward.
☐ To build up capacity for implementing technology-based production. ☐ To provide certified seeds. ☐ Improvement of production environment and restoration of ecological balance through scientific management of land & water.
□ To encourage livestock management.
☐ To provide livelihood support to land less families.
□ Increase the production of Food and Nonfood crops and Fodder.
☐ Encourage the adoption of value addition crops and scientific dry farming techniques instead of the traditional farming system.

This is a special project for sustainable agricultural production from interior backward Area and sloppy rainfed area and bringing more area under two seasonal cultivations. Total 180482 ha area in Islampur sub -division (i.e., Chopra-37840ha, Islampur-36010ha, Goalpokhar-I-35840ha & Karandighi-38584ha), Uttar Dinajpur districts of West Bengal State has been selected under this project considering the need of development of villages.

This project will be implemented under Panchayat & Rural Development Department. The total budget allotted for 2021-22 & onwards in RKVY Scheme including Skilled Development training is amounting Rs.1264975.00 The Scheme has been implemented by this project on Goalpokhar-II block for this period. Maximum farmers & SHGs member of the district villages are covered under RKVY-RAFTAAR programme.

Objective / Aims of the project:


The project was started with the objective to cover agriculture and all allied activities, enhancement of agricultural productivity & production in a sustainable manner.

Goals and Objectives:
CADC has always Comprehensive approach.
Agriculture & Horticulture activities are Sectors only.
\Box Other sectors like ARD, FISHERY, MGNREGS one part of approach.
Skill Development Training on Agriculture and Other allied activities.
Setting up horticulture Farm /Progeny Orchard on Govt. Vested barren land/fallow land/SHG land for producing seeds/Seedlings/ Green fodder/Azolla etc.
Intervention in the identified Backward Villages of the district with Argil inputs, training and activities like animal rearing, fishery etc.
Formation of SHG'S and arrangement to provide economic activities.
CADC fill up critical gap of panchayat bodies and District Administration i.e., where the technical support and assistances required towards upliftment of economic development of the down trodden people.
Support to the panchayat and District Administration specially on training programme of SHG's for undertaking the economic activities as CADC is under the P & RD Dept.,Govt. of West Bengal.
Implementation of different development activities in consultation with panchayat through SHG's like NRLM model.
hoAll staffs/Officers are closely associated with the District Administration
and Panchayat Bodies for implementation of the scheme.
Finally, CADC is now working as Research Oriented Rural Development Unit
of Panchayat Bodies of the concerned District.

All the farmers and villagers of panchayats are benefited in form of Skilled Development Training, Certified paddy seed, cultivation, productivity of land and Animal resource development, organic vegetation is also increased.

1)Total Skilled Development Training 18 nos were completed under this project by taking 540nos of SHGs members resulting of women empowerment.

Shri Ashok Kumar Mandal is a progressive farmer. During 2021–22 he had received good quality of foundation seed of paddy under RKVY Seed Multiplication Programme. During field visit and after completion of paddy cultivation, Amal pramanik, AFA of our office staff reported that after getting the benefit under RKVY SMP, his annual income had risen by 450000 (approx.) annually. He also reported that he had received 70kg of good quality foundation seeds of MTU-7029 paddy which had resulted in his annual production rising by 15–16 quintal per bigha. Similarly others of such farmers were benefitted till date.
