

Success story of Kamdhenu Dairy co-operative (DCS), Sulkud, Tal.Kagal, Dist.Kolhapur.

Kamdhenu dairy co-operative society is established in year 1966 and procuring milk 70 lit per day. Dairy supplying milk to private vendor but to financial loss the milk collection activity of dairy co-operative discontinues.

In year 1990 the few village youth come together and restarted dairies milk collection activities with procurement of 100 lit milk per day. Dairy co-operative stared supplying collected milk to Kolhapur Zilla Sahakari Dudh Utpadak Sangh Ltd; Kolhapur (Gokul milk Union). The elected DCS management committee member(MCM) visited to the various departments of Gokul Milk Union. The MCM made strategic plan for increase the milk procurement.

- •Started implementing Gokul Milk Unions inputs activity on large scale at farmer's door stapes, like Vetrinary helth service, Artificial insemination service, Vaccination, deworming of animals, cultivation of green fodder.
- •Purchased Murrha buffaloes from Haryana and crossbred Cows from Bangalore for increase in daily milk procurement.
- •Orientation of the producer member for participation in Union's upgraded female calf rearing programme .
- •Distributed Chaff cutter machine to reduce fodder wastage and cost of milk production with the help of Central Government, State Government and Gokul milk Union.
- •Organized farmers orientation programme at Union's Micro Training Centre for the adoption of recent techniques for enhancement of productivity of animals. Because of the above strategic planning the milk producer's attitude changed towards the dairy farming. The farmers interest in dairy farming has increased and they are using latest techniques in dairy farming as use of chaff cutters, feeding the feed additives (Mineral mixture, By pass fat, By pass protein), Silage making, Hydroponic technology for green fodder production, improved fodder seed for cultivation of green fodder etc.

With the positive and continual effort of DCS management committee members and milk producers, now DCS milk procurement is average 2500 lit per day. Our MCM not only committed for increase in milk production but also for improve in live hood of farmers through dairy farming.
