Minutes of the 16th State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) meeting of RKVY held on 30.12.2014 in the 3rd Floor Conference Hall of Secretariat under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary, Odisha

The 16th State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) meeting of RKVY was held on 30.12.2014 under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary, Odisha in the 3rd Floor Conference Hall of Secretariat at 3.00 P.M. The list of members & other participants who attended the meeting is placed at **Annexure-I**.

At the outset Principal Secretary to Govt., Agriculture Department welcomed the Chairman, officials of GoI and other members present in the meeting and gave the overview of the scheme. The details of the discussion are as follows:

(1) Confirmation of minutes of the last meeting of SLSC held on 02.07.2014

The minutes of the meeting of 15th SLSC held on 02.07.2014 were circulated to all the members vide Agriculture Department letter No.11442/Ag. Dt.09.07.2014. Since no comments have been received, SLSC confirmed the minutes of the meeting of 15th SLSC.

(2) Action Taken Report (ATR) on the decisions taken in the 15th SLSC meeting.

The Action Taken Report (ATR) on the minutes of the last SLSC meeting was discussed in detail and enclosed in **Annexure-II**.

(3) Physical status of the projects from 2007-08 to 2014-15

Principal Secretary, Agriculture informed that 444 nos. of projects have been implemented since inception of RKVY scheme, of which 258 completed projects have been uploaded in RDMIS. The Chief Secretary-cum-Chairman, SLSC requested the Implementing Agencies to immediately submit project completion details of the completed projects for uploading in RDMIS failing which release of funds for other ongoing projects of the concerned Implementing Agencies will be with held.

(4) Financial progress under RKVY for 2007- 08 to 2014-15

Principal Secretary, Agriculture stated that full Utilization Certificates for funds received during 2007-08 to 2013-14 have been submitted to GoI. For the year 2014-15 amount received from GOI was ₹48207.00 lakh against the allocated amount of the ₹50413.00 lakh. U.C has been submitted for ₹17850.23 lakh. Principal Secretary, Agriculture informed that GoI is being pursued to release the balance amount of ₹2200.00 lakh.

(5) De-sanction of Projects

The proposal of Director Horticulture for de-sanction of 3 nos. of following projects was discussed.

Considering the technical importance of the project “Integrated Pest Management in Mango”, the Committee decided not to de-sanction the same. The Director Horticulture was requested to implement the project. Rest 2 projects namely; 1. Organic adoption and certification of Integrated Horticulture Production System with end to end online traceability in Odisha & 2. Oil Palm tracking system were de-sanctioned.

(6) Progress of sub schemes of RKVY for the year 2014-15

(a) *Bringing Green Revolution to Eastern India (BGREI):*

GoI have allocated ₹18400.00 lakh for BGREI & released the entire amount. The progress of BGREI was discussed in detail. The short fall under Crop Demonstration was due to non-availability of seeds of less than 10 years old paddy varieties. It was decided to divert the savings from Crop Demonstration to other components like; Assets Building, Site Specific Needs & Processing & Marketing Support of Rice. The Chairman emphasized to use solar pump sets for energisation of cluster bore wells/ dug wells as per the Site Specific Needs. Director, Agriculture was requested to revise the Action Plan accordingly and submit to GoI for approval.

(b) Vegetable Initiative for Urban Cluster (VIUC):

GoI have allocated ₹1400.00 lakh under VIUC & released in full. The Chairman requested the Director Horticulture to give a brand name for the Vegetables sold in Udyan Fresh like "Fresh Vegetables" produced from Good Agricultural Practices.

(c) National Mission for Protein Supplements (NMPS):

GoI have allocated ₹1520.00 lakh for Sub-Scheme NMPS & released the entire amount. As GoI have allowed to execute the ongoing projects of 2013-14 utilizing the released amount of 2014-15, the execution of the projects were in progress. The Chairman suggested to ensure distribution of area/ district specific mineral mixture in Gomata Samrudhi Prakalpa.

(7) Sanction of new project proposals

A. The following project proposals submitted by Director, Agriculture & Food Production and Director, Horticulture, Odisha which have been approved by the Chief Secretary-cum-Chairman SLSC, were ratified by the SLSC.

Considering the observation of Govt. of India for the Project "**Promotion of Improved Chick Pea Varieties in Rice Based Cropping System of Small holder Famers in Odisha**" Committee advised Director Agriculture to revise the proposal in respect of mobility/ hiring of manpower & contingency. The OSSC should be entrusted with procurement of 90% of the certified/ foundation seeds produced in the project with the stipulation that cost of deficit in procurement will be recovered from OSSC. SHG/ FIG may be formed for sustainability of the activities undertaken in the project.

B. Discussion on New Project Proposals by SLSC.

Animal Husbandry Sector.

The Director Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services has submitted 07 (Seven) nos. of proposals as follows:-

1. Project Proposal for Strengthening of Mobile Veterinary Unit in Odisha with a total project cost of ₹3921.564 lakh.

The project was discussed in detail and sanctioned by the SLSC. LH Division of GoI has also supported the proposal.

2. Strengthening of District Diagnostic Laboratory (DDL)/ Clinical Investigation Laboratory (CIL) State Veterinary Laboratory (SVL) under RKVY with a total project cost of ₹1294.00 lakh.

The project was discussed in detail and sanctioned by the SLSC. LH Division of GoI has also supported the proposal. There should not be any duplicacy of funds with ASCAD.

3. Project proposal on Supplementation of Mineral Mixture for Enhancing Milk Production under RKVY with a total project cost of ₹1124.00 lakh.

The project was discussed in detail and sanctioned by the SLSC in principle. The project shall be implemented after receipt of the comments of Feed & Fodder unit of GoI.

4. Project proposal on Green Fodder Security through Hydroponics under RKVY with a total project cost of ₹739.34 lakh.

The project was discussed in detail and sanctioned by the SLSC. However, the Committee decided to execute the project on Pilot basis only at one place.

5. Special programme for Goat Development” 2014-15. (NMPS) with a total project cost of ₹499.66 lakh.

The project was discussed in detail and sanctioned by the SLSC.

6. Establishment of Art Referral Laboratory at Teaching Veterinary Clinical Complex (TVCC) with a total project cost of ₹170.00 lakh.

The project was discussed in detail and sanctioned by the SLSC.

7. Dairy Farmers Field School in Peri-urban area of Bhubaneswar with a total project cost of ₹176.60 lakh.

The project was discussed in detail and dropped. The Extension Division of GoI has also not supported the proposal.

Director, Fisheries

Director, Fisheries has submitted 11 (Eleven) Nos. of proposals as follows:-

8. Project Proposal for enhancement of production capacity of Chandrabhaga Shrimp Hatchery, Konark, Puri with a total project cost of ₹200.00 lakh.

The project was discussed in detail and sanctioned by the SLSC in principle. The Committee decided that the project should pay back the amount sanctioned after 2 years of execution.

9. Enhancing Inland Fish Production through Matsya Credit Card in MGNREGS tank with a total project cost of ₹93.00 lakh.

10. Assistance for Net & Boat to Inland & Riverine fishermen with a total project cost of ₹612.00 lakh.

11. Assistance for Fish marketing infrastructure for Inland, Marine & Chilika Fishermen with a total project cost of ₹103.53 lakh.

12. Enhancing inland fish production through intensive aquaculture in tanks and ponds during 2014-15 under National Mission for Protein Supplements (NMPS) with a total project cost of ₹702.00 lakh.

13. Aquaculture Development through Integrated approach in Sahada GP of Bissam Cuttack Block of Rayagada District, Odisha. (NMPS) with a total project cost of ₹250.00 lakh.

14. Demonstration and Development of Aquaculture Crop Based Integrated Farming System in waterlogged wasteland areas of Puri District, Odisha.(NMPS) with a total project cost of ₹568.00 lakh.

15. Project Proposal on Aquaculture Development through integrated approach in Gop Block of Puri District. (NMPS) with a total project cost of ₹1022.00 lakh.

16. Project Proposal on Demonstration of Feed based Aquaculture for enhancing inland fish production under RKVY with a total project cost of ₹190.00 lakh.

OMFED.

The OMFED has submitted 03 (Three) Nos. of proposals as follows:-

19. Concrete Flooring of Cowshed phase -II with a total project cost of ₹442.53 lakh.

The project was discussed in detail and sanctioned by the SLSC with maximum subsidy of 25% admissible to farmers and other expenses like colour photos, software etc. to be met within 1% administrative expenses.

20. Expansion of plant equipment at Balasore Dairy to handle surplus Milk Production by farmers of Balasore, Bhadrak & Mayurbhanj district in Odisha with a total project cost of ₹57.75 lakh.

The project was discussed in detail and sanctioned by the SLSC. The Committee advised that the project should pay back after one year.

21. Gomamata Samridhi Prakalp (GSP-II) with a total project cost of ₹504.00 lakh.

The project was discussed in detail and sanctioned by the SLSC.

It was decided to place the following two nos. of project proposals submitted by FARD Department before next SLPSC for scrutiny:-

DA & FP(O)

The DA & FP (O) has submitted 03 (Three) Nos. of proposals as follows:-

22. Introduction & Expansion of improved Pigeon pea (Arhar) Production Technology in rain fed up land eco system of Odisha with a total project cost of ₹818.39 lakh.

The project was discussed in detail and sanctioned by the SLSC in principle. However, the DA & FP(O) was advised to recast the project in respect of mobility/ hiring of manpower & contingency before release of funds.

23. Project proposal on Paddy Nursery Raising by Hydroponic Method-a new Intervention under RKVY, 2014-15 with a total project cost of ₹50.00 lakh.

The project was discussed in detail and sanctioned by the SLSC. However, only one machine may be installed on pilot basis in a Govt. farm.

24. Popularization of Agricultural Machinery/ Implements with a total project cost of ₹24.95 lakh.

The project was discussed in detail and sanctioned by the SLSC.

25. Establishment of Seventeen New Soil Testing Laboratory with a total project cost of ₹1700.00 lakh.

However, the result of soil testing in the laboratories should be used by Agriculture Deptt. to update digitized soil map of the state from time to time.

The project was discussed in detail & it was decided to put it on hold.

DA&FP (O) has submitted another project "Establishment of Automatic Weather Stations Networks in Odisha" with a project cost of Rs.450.00 lakh which was discussed & it was decided to place it in the next SLPSC for scrutiny.

Director, Horticulture

The Director, Horticulture, Odisha has submitted 10 (ten) nos. of proposals as follows:-

26. Sustainable intensification of potato in rice based system in Odisha for increased productivity & profitability. with a total project cost of ₹1351.20 lakh.

The project was discussed in detail and approved by the SLSC in principle. However, it was decided that the Director Horticulture may revise the Project on the basis of GoI observations & submit the same for consideration and approval of Chairman before release of funds.

27. Construction of Naturally Ventilated Poly Green House for cultivation of flowers & Vegetables with a total project cost of ₹713.80 lakh.

The project was discussed in detail and dropped.

28. Establishment of Horticulture Training Centre-cum-Farmers Hostel at CHES, Bhubaneswar with a total project cost of ₹570.00 lakh.

The project was discussed in detail and sanctioned by the SLSC. However, it was decided that the Director Horticulture is to obtain comments of ICAR before release of funds.

29. Development of Block Level Nursery Harabhanga, Boudh with a total project cost of ₹22.60 lakh.

30. Development of Block Level Nursery Kantamal, Boudh with a total project cost of ₹22.60 lakh.

31. Development of Horticultural Nursery at Boudh Farm with a total project cost of ₹113.30 lakh.

All the above three projects (Sl. No.29,30,31) were discussed in detail and sanctioned by the SLSC with a stipulation to get the Nurseries accredited within 18 months of establishment through NHB/ SAU/ ICAR. Farmers Hostel & Staff Quarter are not permissible under RKVY as these are not nursery activities.

32. Skill Development of Rural Entrepreneurs with a total project cost of ₹110.00 lakh.

The project was discussed in detail and sanctioned by the SLSC.

33. Project for strengthening water bodies and land scraping with a total project cost of ₹18.90 lakh.

34. Construction of compound wall around Deras Horticulture Farm with a total project cost of ₹2185.00 lakh.

35. Additional requirement of fund for construction of Farm Information & Technology Centre at Phulabani with a total project cost of ₹26.32 lakh.

All the above three projects (Sl. No.33,34,35) were discussed & dropped.

M.D., OSSC

52. Development of suitable technique for including dormancy to reduce Pre Harvest Sprouting (PHS) in commonly cultivated paddy varieties with a total project cost of ₹27.30 lakh.

53. Strengthening of Centre of Pulses Research at Berhampur with a total project cost of ₹734.08 lakh.

54. Holistic development of RRTTS Bhawanipatna with a total project cost of ₹211.09 lakh.

55. Holistic development of RRTTS Ranital, Bhadrak with a total project cost of ₹688.18 lakh.

Director, Sericulture

The Director, Sericulture, Odisha has submitted 01 (one) proposal namely:-

58. Additional requirement for Development of Sericulture with a total project cost of ₹187.426 lakh.

The project was discussed in detail and sanctioned by the SLSC.

The Committee decided that, all the projects should commence from 2015-16 except those projects which are crop/ need based and the work in respect of which has already started. The list of 48 Nos. of sanctioned projects with year-wise requirement of funds is given in Annexure-III.

(8) Miscellaneous Issues

- i. The proposal to engage NABCONS a sister organization of NABARD for concurrent Evaluation & Monitoring of RKVY Projects was approved by the SLSC. The expenditure will be met from 1% administrative cost of RKVY.
- ii. The proposal for putting in place an effective monitoring system with GPS features submitted by Director, Agriculture will be placed before SLPSC. The project should be implemented jointly by ORSAC and DA & FP (O) with active involvement of other implementing agencies.
- iii. The proposal for revival of Mangalpur-II defunct Tube well in place of Bahilipada tube well project under BGREI submitted by OLIC was approved by the SLSC without any financial implication.
- iv. Hiring of manpower and mobility support/hiring of vehicles in case of Research oriented Project Proposals of International/ National/State Institutes like CIP, ICRISAT and OUAT will be allowed within 1% overall administrative cost of RKVY.
- v. Transfer of 34 Soil testing laboratories established by PACS to DA &FP (O) was approved by SLSC.
- vi. The project proposal of "Establishment of Coconut Training Institute in Kerandia Farm, Brahmagiri , Puri district" established in Maheswari Farm due to lack of space was approved post-facto by SLSC.

- vii. The proposal of DA & FP (O) for diversion of funds for conducting Cluster Demonstration on Post-Harvest & Value Addition, Development of Market Link Support, District Level PMG Contingency, Publicity etc. which could not be utilized during 2013-14 & Kharif 2014, to be utilized for conducting cluster demonstration on paddy & maize during Rabi 2014-15 was discussed in the SLSC and it was decided to conduct the demonstration after getting approval from concerned Division of GoI.
- viii. The revised proposal of OSCDC Ltd. on Infrastructure Development work in different nurseries without any financial implication was discussed and the Committee suggested to take the approval of Chairman, SLSC separately.















