I am directed to inform that the existing Innovation and Agri Entrepreneurship programme under "Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana - Remunerative Approaches for Agriculture and Allied Sector Rejuvenation (RKVY-RAFTAAR)" of DAC&FW stands extended beyond 31st March 2020 for a period upto 31st March 2021 or till the date of revised CCEA approval based on recommendations of the 15th Finance Commission coming into effect, whichever is earlier. The said programme will continue to be implemented by the designated Knowledge Partners (KPs) and RKVY-RAFTAAR Agribusiness Incubators (R-ABIs) appointed by DAC&FW in 2018-19. Hence, after completion of the infrastruce work, the unutilized funds, if any, under the capital expenditure head may be surrendered to this department in due course. Monitoring and submission of reports on performance and achievements of startups already funded under the programme in the previous years COHORTs may be done by the respective KP/RABI. Due Diligence/ physical verification of Startup business under the programme may also be done by the respective KP/RABI. The details of the programme activities along with budget allocation, human resources etc. for all RABIs during the financial year 2020-21 are at Annexure-II (a, b, c & d).

The remaining terms and conditions will be the same as mentioned in the existing operational guideline of Innovation and Agri-entrepreneurship programme under RKVY-RAFTAAR, amendments made in guideline and MoU signed between DAC & FW and KPs.
