Subject: Minutes of the Video Conference held with States/UTs on 04.09.2019 for reviewing the implementation of RKVY-RAFTAAR - reg.

A video conference was organized on 04.09.2019 under the chairmanship of Ms. Chhavi Jha, Joint Secretary (RKVY) of this Department between 03.00 PM to 05.00 PM with the representatives of all States/UTs to review/discuss the status of implementation of RKVY-RAFTAAR with the officers of all the participating States Government. The State Governments of Andhra Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Goa, Gujarat, Haryana, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Jharkhand, Pradesh. Himachal Maharashtra, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Odisha, Punjab, Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, Tripura Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand and West Bengal & UT of Pudducherry participated in the video conference.

- 2. The following agenda was the basic purpose of the Video Conference:
 - (i) Discussion on 2nd installment of funds release status for 2019-20.
 - (ii) Status of Unspent Balances of previous years.
 - (iii) Status of Physical & financial progress reports.
 - (iv) Status of RKVY- RDMIS entries.
 - (v) Status of Geo-tagging of RKVY assets.
 - (vi) Status of 3rd party evaluation.
 - (vii) Status of preparation of action plan of sub-schems allocated to the States
 - (viii) Suggestions for incorporation in Expenditure Finance committee (EFC)
 - (ix) List of projects.
 - (x) Success story.
 - (xi) Any other suggestions / pending issues, etc.
- **3.** The Joint Secretary (RKVY) welcomed representatives of all the participating States in the Video Conference. The issues discussed with the States participated in the video conference are as under:

ANDHRA PRADESH

- 2nd installment of funds for 2019-20 will be availed by the State at the end of October, 2019 after submission of pending UCs of Rs. 54.18 crore for 2018-19.
- State has submitted proposal for CDP, AFDP and ANMHLT sub scheme to the Chief Secretary of the State on 29.08.2019. Funds released for AIEC sub-scheme.
- The State is facing issue in uploading the details of Animal Husbandry projects in RKVY-MIS. State was advised to submit screen shot of problems being faced to this Division.
- Progress of geo-tagging is good. So far 43187 assets have been geo-tagged. However, State has about 4000 more assets to be geo-tagged.

ARUNACHAL PRADESH

- Minutes of SLSC meeting are pending.
- State may submit details regarding non- release of RKVY funds by the State Finance department.
- State has submitted Action Plan for RPS and ANMHLT sub-scheme.
- RKVY-MIS entries of Agriculture Department are complete. However, State needs to make pending MIS entries of allied Department projects.
- So far, only 448 assets have been geo tagged out of total 10000 expected assets.

ASSAM

- > State will avail 2nd installment of funds for 2019-20 by October 2019.
- State informed that pending UCs of previous year 2015-16 and 2016-17 will be reconciled. However, State has submitted revalidation proposal for pending UCs of Rs. 28.38 crore for 2017-18, which is under approval in IFD.
- Funds released for BGREI sub scheme. State needs to submit action plan for ANMHLT sub scheme.
- State informed that the task of geo tagging will pick up since NRC is now complete.

BIHAR
