Minutes of the Meeting of the State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) for Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojna (RKVY) held under the Chairmanship of Mr. B. R. Sharma, Chief Secretary, J&K Government, on 29.11.2016.

The List of the Participants is enclosed as **Annexure "A"**.

1. At the outset, Financial Commissioner, Agriculture Production Department (APD) welcomed the Chief Secretary, J&K and other Members of the Committee. Thereafter, the agenda circulated by the Agriculture Production Department for the today's meeting was considered by the Committee.

Agenda Point No: 1: Consideration and approval of Draft Action Plan for control of Foot and Mouth Disease in bovines under RKVY (Normal) for Rs. 300.02 Lacs

2. The Committee was informed that initially an amount of Rs. 3701.00 lacs comprising Rs. 3331.00 lacs as Central Share and Rs. 370.00 lacs as State Share for the financial year 2016-17 under RKVY was approved by it in its meeting held on 17.06.2016. Subsequently, the Government of India, Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare & Co-operation revised the allocation and intimated the final allocation of Rs. 4000.03 lacs comprising Rs. 3600.02 lacs as Central Share and Rs. 400.00 lacs as State Share, for the financial year 2016-17 under the Scheme.

3. The Committee was further informed that Rs. 302.00 lacs comprising of Rs. 272.00 lacs as Central Share and Rs. 30.00 lacs as State Share is proposed to be allocated to the Animal and Sheep Husbandry Department Jammu/Kashmir for Foot and Mouth Disease Control Programme. Director Agriculture Kashmir (Mission Director) presented the Action Plan for control of Foot and Mouth Disease in bovines under RKVY with the financial implication of Rs. 302.00 lacs. The Committee approved the proposal.

Agenda point No: 2: To review the progress under RKVY and its sub-schemes 2016-17 (Physical & Financial) ending October, 2016

While reviewing the physical and financial targets of the Scheme, it was noted that no substantial progress has been made by the concerned departments/HoDs. The Committee impressed upon the concerned departments/HoDs to put in their best efforts for achieving the targets. The Committee also stressed upon the Agriculture Production Department to prepare the Action Plan for the year 2017-18 by December, 2016 positively so that the same can be processed for early approval by the Government of India.




Agenda point No:3 : Follow up action on the decisions taken in the SLSC Meeting held on 17.06.2016

4. Financial Commissioner, Agriculture Production Department informed that most of the departments have not furnished the Action Taken Reports on the implementation of the decisions taken by the Committee in its meeting held on 17.06.2016. Chief Secretary desired the Financial Commissioner, Agriculture to convene a review meeting of the concerned HoDs/Departments for expeditious implementation of the decisions taken in the above meeting.

5. In addition to the above, following instructions were issued to be complied with by the concerned HoDs/Departments so that tangible results are achieved on ground through implementation of RKVY, a component of which is Saffron Mission.

- i. The Agriculture Production Department in consultation with SKUAST (K/J) will identify the bottlenecks responsible for the reported decline in the Saffron Production over the past one decade. Besides, the Department will take pro-active steps to ensure provision of irrigation facilities to the Saffron Crops as crop loss is being attributed to the lack of irrigation facilities.
- ii. The Planning, Development & Monitoring Department will undertake an evaluation study to ascertain the impact of the Saffron Mission especially with regard to the irrigation component on the Saffron productivity during the past decade.
- iii. With a view to reconciling the figures projected by different departments, a joint crop cut experiment/scientific study will be got conducted by SKUAST (K/J), so as to arrive at reliable statistical data about the production/productivity figures in all major crops including Saffron.
- iv. The activities under RKVY need to be prioritized in the selected Panchayats/Blocks so that the same can act as plot(s) for demonstration. These demonstration plot (s) will not only highlight the progress made under the Scheme but will also serve as a model to be replicated by other farmers.
- v. As regards allocation of funds under the National Mission on Saffron for the year 2016-17, the Agriculture Production Department will take up the matter with the Government of India for release of Central Share matching with the State Share. Further, the Agriculture Production Department will endorse the copies of communications where-under State Share is released under all Centrally Sponsored Schemes including RKVY to Government of India, to ensure early release of the matching Central Share.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
