MINUTES OF THE STATE LEVEL SANCTIONING COMMITTEE (SLSC) MEETING OF
RKVY AND SEWP HELD ON 7TH SEPTEMBER, 2017 AT THE CONFERENCE HALL OF
THE CHIEF SECRETARY, ITANAGAR

1. The State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) meeting of RKVY Schemes was held on 7th September, 2017 under the Chairmanship of the in-charge Chief Secretary, Shri B. Pertin, IAS, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh. The meeting was attended by the members from Agriculture and its allied Sectors and Dr. K. Manoharan, Director, Directorate of Jute, Kolkata, the representative from the Ministry of Agriculture, Cooperation and Farmers Welfare, Govt. of India to consider and approve the Project Proposals of Agriculture and allied Departments under Normal Rashtriya Krishi Vikash Yojana (RKVY), Sub-scheme (RKVY) for reclamation of acid soil and SEWP (State Extension Work Plan) under NMAET (National Mission on Agriculture Extension Technology). List of the participants is annexed at Annexure "A".
2. While welcoming the members present Mrs. Y.W. Ringu, IAS, the Secretary (Agriculture), Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh, appraised the house about the aims and the objective of the SLSC meeting and informed that the SLSC is to approve/sanction the proposals ~~of the important~~ centrally sponsored schemes (CSS) namely:
 - (A) Normal scheme of Rastriya Krishi Vikash Yojana (RKVY),
 - (B) RKVY sub-scheme for Agriculture Department for reclamation of acidic soil and
 - (C) The State Extension Work Plan (SEWP) under NMAET (National Mission on Agriculture Extension Technology).

It was informed to the House that a meeting was convened on 31st August 2017 by the Addl. Secy., Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Krishi Bhawan, New Delhi which was a pre consultative meeting, the First of its kind, for having an in depth discussion on the proposals submitted as recommended by the SLPSC held on 18th July'2017 at office chamber of Secretary Agriculture, Itanagar. However, the meeting notice was received just one day ahead. All Line Departments were informed to send their representatives but except for Agriculture and AH & Vet. Department no Line Department was represented. Ministry took a very serious view on such absence and instructed that henceforth all Departments should send their representatives.

The Secretary (Agriculture) through a power point presentation dwelt on length on the General Comments received from the Under Secretary (DAC & FW), Department of Agriculture, Cooperation and Farmers Welfare, Govt. of India on the project proposals under RKVY scheme during 2017-2018 in respect of Arunachal Pradesh point wise followed by PPT on achievements/status of implementation under RKVY scheme in the state.

3. Dr. K. Manoharan, Director, Directorate of Jute, Kolkata, the representative from the Ministry of Agriculture, Cooperation and Farmers Welfare, Govt. of India stressed on the need to submit UCs on time and he pointed out the guidelines issued by the Ministry has to be followed by all concerned.
4. Further the Secretary (Agriculture), Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh proceeded ahead with the power point presentation on the project proposals under Normal RKVY, RKVY (Sub-scheme) fund and SEWP- 2017-2018. Then discussion on each project proposal under Agriculture department was made and the House approved all the proposals as proposed with minor modification/rectifications. It was informed to the House that the DPR 2017-2018 was already prepared and the Director Agriculture and State Nodal officer were of the opinion that the fund amounting to Rs:25.00 lakh earmarked/proposed for Consultation fees was not required. And that there is acute need of renovation of non residential buildings for the proper functioning of the Department all over the State. Therefore, it was proposed before the House that the amount earmarked/ proposed for Consultation fee be placed under Renovation of Departmental infrastructures. The House approved the proposal including all the proposals of the Department of Agriculture.

5. The power point presentation on project proposals under Department of Horticulture was made by Mrs. Mimum Tayeng, IAS, Secretary Horticulture, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh and she explained in detail about the requirement of change in proposals proposed before the House.

After detailed discussion on the project proposals submitted by Department of Horticulture, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh under RKVY Programme during the year 2017-2018, the members of SLSC present in the meeting have considered the proposals with the changes as proposed for obtaining approval of the Ministry of Agriculture, Cooperation and Farmers Welfare, Govt. of India with the following changes:-

- (i) The number of units proposed for project at SL.No.1 of Production Growth Stream to be increased from 100 units to 250 units.
- (ii) Crops under project at SL.No.2 of Production Growth Stream to be restricted to cultivation of Blueberry or Strawberry or any other temperate Crop subject to availability of planting materials, with a decrease in the units proposed from 200 Ha to 40 Ha.

6. Shri Tahang Taggu, IAS, Commissioner, (AH & Vety, Textile and Handicrafts, Fisheries,) made the power point presentation on project proposals put by the Department of AH & Vety, Textile and Handicrafts, Fisheries etc. either with change of nomenclature, giving justification on the requirement of the project proposals of the above departments. On Pending Utilization Certificate's with Fisheries Department, it was stated by the Department Officers that they would submit the Utilization Certificate against RKVY fund 2015-2016 and a status report statement was submitted before the house where the Physical Progress in most of the schemes was shown as 100%. The house directed the department to submit the Utilization Certificate within 10 days and if not, the Department of Fisheries will have to surrender the rest of the fund for the year 2015 - 2016 by first week of October, 2017. The Commissioner (Fisheries) proposed that in lieu of the proposal for Commercial Fish Pond, the department is proposing for Fingerlings Cultivation in view of GOI's reservation on the proposal. The House approved the same. It was directed that the Director (Fishery) will submit the Non Duplicity Certificate as required under the Scheme.

7. In view of standing observations and comments from Under Secretary (DAC & FW), Govt. of India, all the Project Proposal under Production Growth Programme: (a) Dairy-50 units, (b) Piggery-200 units, (c) Mithun-50 units and (d) Yak-10 units by AH & Vety Department was approved by the house on the basis of the justification given by department. They were asked to furnish proper justification note on project proposals and non duplication certificate as all these proposals are ongoing project under RKVY in Arunachal Pradesh. Under Infrastructure and Asset, the proposal for construction of residence Quarter-cum- Officer building it was proposed that all buildings are basically to be used for non residential purposes i.e. Office building. The rates were told to be quoted as per Arunachal Pradesh State Schedule Rate (APSR). It was directed that the Director (Animal Husbandry & Veterinary) will submit the Non Duplicity Certificate as required under the Scheme

8. Project proposals under Soil and Water Conservation, ^{was} explained in detail by Shri Joram Pupa, Director, Soil and Water Conservation, RWD. It clarified by Secretary (Agriculture) that the Acidic Soil Treatment for Soil and Water Conservation Treatment Catchment Areas and the agricultural fields under catchment areas are to be done by the RWD and in respect of field crop the same will be done by Agriculture Department. The RKVY Sub-scheme fund for reclamation of Acidic Soil Programme for the year 2017-2018 is allotted to Agriculture Department from the DAC & FW, Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Govt. of India. The Soil and Water Conservation, RWD can propose fund required for reclamation of acidic soil treatment from normal RKVY fund within the earmarked amount allotted to them as observed and commented by GOI. Other Proposals of the department were approved as proposed. It was directed that the Director (Soil and Water Conservation, RWD) will submit the Non Duplicity Certificate as required under the Scheme.

9. Cooperation Department was asked to follow the APSP, APPWD cost norm in construction of Agricultural Godown in the state. These projected areas should be geo-tagged and proper storage facilities should be incorporated in the Godown. Other Proposals of the Department were approved as proposed. It was directed that the RCS will submit the Non Duplicity Certificate as required under the Scheme
10. On pending UCs and implementation of fund released during 2016-2017 and pending state matching share, Shri Pallav Dey, Director, (State Plan) was requested to release the state matching share immediately as RKVY is a National Flagship Programme and is time bound project. In addition to normal RKVY project proposal, it was entreated to release the fund proposed for RKVY sub-scheme for Reclamation of Acidic Soil Treatment.
11. SEWP (State Extension Work Plan) for 'Submission on Agriculture Extension-ATMA' amounting to Rs:2596.145 lakh approved "in Principle" by the in-charge Chief Secretary-cum-Chairman (SLSC) as per Ministry of Agriculture, Govt. of India's instruction was also formally ratified by the SLSC (State Level Sanctioning Committee), 2017-2018.

The approved projects by SLSC under Agriculture and allied department are shown at Appendix-I, II, III, IV, V, VI, VII enclosed.

12. It was requested by the Secretary (Agriculture) that the state matching shares for the Agriculture and allied Sectors be earmarked in total as projected released immediately as we have the target to double farmer's income by 2022 and also to go the Organic way.

13. Shri Bilatee Pertin, the in-charge Chief Secretary stated the though the Government of India is supporting the proposals for area expansion and the fencing of agricultural / horticultural areas and targeting on post harvest management, in reality and in the context of the state like Arunachal Pradesh, it is imperative that the focus has to be made on area expansion and the fencing of Agricultural / Horticultural areas if we have to develop these sectors. Grazing is unregulated in Arunachal Pradesh. Farmers incur huge crop damage loss due to animals. The farm operation is incomplete without the provision of proper fencing. The Govt. of India's funded schemes do not have the provision of fencing which is a matter of concern for us. On the other hand the animal rearing is deeply attached to the social, cultural, traditional values of the tribal communities of the state. The rearing of Yaks and Mithuns the semi domesticated animals are indispensable.

Without focus on area expansion and the fencing of Agricultural / Horticultural areas, the real development in these sectors cannot be achieved.

Dr. K. Manoharan, attending representative from Govt. of India was apprised of the farm situation in Arunachal Pradesh and requests him to impress upon the DAC & FW, Govt. of India to consider project proposal for area expansion under various crop and provision of fencing to contain interference of animals in crop field.

He said there should be quarterly review of the Performance/Progress of RKVY scheme among the Agriculture and allied sector Departments to deal with non submission of Utilization Certificate. To address the genuine problems and requirement of grower, the endeavor should be made to provide innovative technology and input assistance to the farmers.

14. It was decided that all the Departments will submit UCs along with photographs with date and as far as possible should be geo tagged.






